## Traffic Delays in Talent

The Bear Creek Valley Sanitary Authority (BCVSA) will begin construction of the Main Street – Wagner Creek Road Sewer Rehabilitation project in Talent on Monday, April 17, 2000. The work will involve replacing the sewer main from the intersection of Second Street and Main Street to the intersection of Wagner Creek Road and Rapp Road. The work is being performed by Timber Mountain Construction from Gold Hill. The project is expected to take **four to six weeks** to complete. Local residents should be advised to expect traffic delays during this period and to seek alternative routes if possible.
