IT DOES MEAN THAT 95 WATER WORKS OPERATORS UNDERTOOK TO SUBMIT THE REQUIRED NUMBER OF WATER SAMPLES FOR BACTERIOLOGICAL ANALYSIS EACH AND EVERY MONTH OF THE YEAR AND ACHIEVED THEIR GOAL OF A PERFECT RECORD FOR THE YEAR. IT IS TRUE THAT NOT ALL WATER WORKS OPERATORS HAVE EQUAL OPPORTUNITIES FOR SUCH A RECORD. SOME WATER SYSTEMS ARE BETTER THAN OTHERS--SOME HAVE BETTER SOURCES, OTHERS HAVE BETTER TREATMENT FACILITIES. ALL HAVE EQUAL OPPORTUNITY FOR SUBMITTING SAMPLES. BY FAR, THE GREATEST OBSTACLE TO A PERFECT RECORD IS LACK OF SAMPLES.
